Annual Stipend Requirements

Applicants who receive a scholarship are eligible to receive an annual stipend for at least four academic years. The stipends are awarded for the fall semester.

Applicants must remain a member of Allen to be eligible for the annual stipend and must provide proof of enrollment for the upcoming semester. Proof may be in the form of a letter from the school acknowledging their enrollment, class schedule, payment receipt, bill, etc.

Applicants who are enrolled in school less than fulltime (less than 12 hours) who received a scholarship will be awarded a stipend for one half of the total amount awarded that particular year.

Submission of Applications

The deadline for receipt of all completed application packages will be established each year by the Scholarship Committee.
